

LEWISTOWN'S CITY PARKS



FRANK DAY CITY PARK: End of Fifth Avenue South. Picnic tables, barbecues, playground equipment, Labyrinth garden, outdoor Olympic-size pool & double plumed waterslide, volleyball pit, winter ice-skating rink and warming house.

SYMMES PARK: East Main Street between Ridgelawn and Prospect streets. Tennis court, playground equipment, picnic tables, baseball diamond and horseshoes. Lewistown Area Chamber of Commerce and museum are also located at the edge of the park.

TRIANGLE PARK: Along the walking trail at the corner of 10th Ave North and Washington Street. Playground equipment and a picnic table. Also known as Railroad Park.

REED'S FORT POST OFFICE: On Casino Creek Drive between Brassey and Shields Streets. Site of historic Reed's Fort Post Office, a small log structure which once served as a military post office. Picnic area.



HAWTHORNE PARK: 204 W Evelyn Street, playground equipment, baseball diamond, basketball court, picnic tables.

KIWANIS PARK: 1103 Seventh Ave North, basketball court, baseball diamond, playground equipment, picnic tables.

D'AUTREMONT SOFTBALL COMPLEX: On Airport Road Softball fields, walking trail nearby. Home of Montana Softball Hall of Fame.

JAYCEES PARK: At the corner of Park Avenue and Cottonwood Street. Baseball diamond, basketball court, children's play area.

FROG PONDS: West Spring Street walking trails, fishing ponds, educational kiosks, wildlife viewing.

VETERAN'S PARK: At the Mill Ditch, next to the Yogo Inn Picnic table, benches.

SCHOOL PARK: Fourth Ave South and Cook Street, adjacent to Frank Day park. Baseball diamond and basketball court.

ROBINSON PARK: Along Airport Rd, next to the Frog Ponds. Trail/Nature Park

BREWERY FLATS: Along Spring Creek Rd. Walking trails, nature park, fishing, wildlife viewing.



EAST FORK RESERVOIR: About 11 miles southeast of Lewistown, take Route 238. Ed McGivern Picnic and Campground, fishing, boating (no wake rule), hiking and wildlife viewing. Ice fishing in the winter.

FISH HATCHERY: Seven miles south of Lewistown on Spring Creek Rd. Picnic area with shelter and tables, baseball diamond, volleyball area, bird-watching and a feeding pond.

HANSON CREEK DAM: Located one mile beyond the Fish Hatchery. Fishing, wildlife viewing.

LEWISTOWN TRAIL SYSTEM: We have over 20 miles of trails.
