Open Public Participation:


No public participation.

Committee Member Comments:



The preference of the study commission is to put the survey in the Lewistown News Argus and to do an announcement on KXLO to let the public know about the survey. Kevin Myhre suggested having a space on the survey for names and location. The topic of the city charter was brought up. Krillenberger would like to take several meetings to cover sections of the charter. Ellestad suggested covering a portion of the charter and interview a department head at each meeting.
