
New Snow Route Information

Certain streets have been designated as Tier I or Tier II Snow Routes and will have limited parking from November 1 through May 1 in order to clear and maintain the city streets and to allow for safe vehicular traffic and parking.

Tier 2 Routes

Tier II Snow Routes are important routes to access services around the City. From November 1 through May 1, parking on Tier II Snow Routes shall alternate based on the calendar day.

Even Calendar Days: On even calendar days, vehicles, trailers, or equipment shall be parked only on that side of the street having even-numbered street addresses between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 11:00 A.M. of the following day.

Odd Calendar Days: On odd calendar days, vehicles, trailers, or equipment shall be parked only on that side of the street having odd-numbered street addresses between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 11:00 A.M. of the following day.

How will I know

Each fall the City of Lewistown will publish a notice in the paper, discuss on the radio and post flyers around the community, to notify the public of the parking restrictions.

Tier 2 Streets

Odd and Even Parking from November 1 to May 1

- Boulevard Street, from Elm to Entrance Avenue
- C Street, from Entrance Avenue to Wendell Avenue
- 7th Avenue from Main Street to 1st Street/Truck By Pass
- 4th Avenue N, from Boulevard Street to Truck By Pass
- 4th Avenue South, from Main Street to Water Street
- 6th Avenue, from Main Street to Earl's Street
- 5th Avenue, from Main Street to Brassey Street
- 3rd Avenue, from Main Street to Water Street
- Water Street, from 5th Avenue to 1st Avenue
- Watson Street, from 4th Avenue to 3rd Avenue
- 10th Avenue South, from Spring Street to Main Street
- Spring Street, from 10th Avenue to Lower Airport Road

Frequently Asked Questions

- What if it is not snowing?

These Parking restrictions are in effect from November 1 to May 1 and not based on the weather.

- What side of the street should I park on at 2 pm?

You can park on either side of the street, but between 11:00 P.M. and 11:00 A.M. you must park on the side of the street that corresponds with the date on the calendar.

Penalties

Any vehicle, motor vehicle, trailer or equipment parked in violation of this section may be ticketed and/or towed. In addition to any fine the registered owner of such vehicle, trailer, or equipment may be responsible for all towing and storage expenses.

Every person convicted of a violation of this section shall be punished by a fine of \$25.00. For a second conviction within one (1) year after the first conviction, the person shall be punished by a fine of \$50.00. Upon a third or subsequent conviction within one (1) year after the first conviction, the person shall be punished by a fine of \$100.00.
